



## STATE POLICY RACE CALANDER & ALTERATIONS

The Annual race meeting calendar is organized by the State Karting Council, in consultation with the affiliated clubs, prior to each racing year. It is set out to minimize clashes between adjoining clubs and between “major” race meetings. This is obviously in the best interest of the clubs and the karter.

Clubs within the same Zone may conduct Race meetings on the same weekend if agreement is made between the Clubs involved.

Once the Council finally adopts the race calendar, changes to the adopted race calendar can only be approved by the Council and in between Council meetings by the State Executive Committee.

A calendar change can be approved by way of a fax vote of clubs or applications of mutual consent between affected clubs, any application for a change must be made a minimum of 5 weeks prior to the proposed event. A non-refundable application fee of \$50 will apply to all applications for changes, and must accompany the written formal request.

The Council / Affiliated Clubs will be given 4 days to respond to any fax vote for such changes. The host club will be responsible for the preparation of the information to be sent to the clubs in support of the change.

Any club may request a letter of objection be distributed to all voting clubs within the 4-day voting period.

### **Exceptions**

A request from the National Karting Council or National Secretariat, for a date to be provided for a National Championship or “major promotional meeting” can be approved by the Secretariat.
