

Sportsman All Stars Series Supplementary Regulations

Authority:

The meetings of the series will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FISA, the General Karting Regulations of the AKA and any further addendums and bulletins to the regulations. Refer Rules 1.07 and 11.02. These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the supplementary regulations issues for each event.

Name of Event: Sportsman All Star Series

Eligible Classes: Sportsman Light, Sportsman Heavy and Sportsman Super Heavy.

Trophies and Prizes and Prize money, Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd, prize money of \$650 1st, \$375 for 2nd, \$180 for 3rd and \$125 for the most improved "C" grade licence holder in each class (to be determined by the series coordinator) will be presented at the end of the series. All series nomination fees go directly into the cash pool and it is possible that cash pool prize amount may increase. Random draw for donated prizes at each round.

Event Dates: Rd1, 30th January Townsville
Rd 2, 20th February Mackay
Rd 3, 6th March Townsville
Rd 4, 29th May Townsville
Rd 5, 19/20 June Townsville (NQ Titles)

Series entry fee: \$100

Tyres: Only 3 sets of MG Reds will be permitted to be used through out the series, tyres will be marked and bar codes read, you must present new tyres for marking at the first round and any subsequent time new ones are fitted.

Race day entry fee: Race day entry fee will be as noted in the approved Supplementary Regulations for each round – determined by each club.

Series entry close. 12.00 pm Saturday the 30th January (Rd 1 Townsville) it is possible to race the series from the 2nd round but the round you missed will count as the dropped round allowed in the series. Early entries post to John Doolan 4 Sunbury Court Annandale Townsville 4814. Series entry form is available on the Townsville Kart Club Web site.

Series Points Calculation:

Heats races, 5 points for every kart that completes a heat, DNF and DNS 0 points
Pre-final and Finals 25 points 1st place, 20 points 2nd, 18 points 3rd, 16 points 4th, 14 points 5th and so on.
Minimum points for completion of the final is 4 points, DNF will be awarded 4 points DNS receive 0 points.
Your worst points round will be dropped for total series points calculations and round by round score sheet will be posted on the Townsville Kart club Web site.
Pointed will be added as the series progresses and the highest points after worst round dropped will be the winner. In the event of a draw the highest placed finisher at the final round will determine the finish positions.
