

Supplementary regulations: Southern Star Series 2010

Authority:

The series will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Karting regulations of the AKA, and any further addendums and bulletins to the regulations. Refer to rule 1.07 and 11.02. These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the supplementary regulations issued for each event/round.

Promoters: Gold Coast Kart Club, Cooloola Coast Kart Club, Lismore Kart Club, Toowoomba Kart Club and Warwick Kart Club.

Classes: Support Classes: Midgets, Rookies, Junior National Light, Over 40
125 Restricted Light & Heavy
Series Classes: Jmax, Rotax Light, Rotax Heavy, Clubman Light,
Clubman Heavy

Format of Racing at all rounds:

Support Classes: As per the regulations of the day.
Main Classes: Time trial Final only counts, per the supplementary regulations of the day.

Note: Time Trialling will be done immediately after 3 lap carburation session for 4 minutes.

Trophies: Club provide trophies at each round

Series places winners, 1st to 3rd place, will receive series trophies.

In the event of a tie in points, a count back from each round will ensue. (IE. Most 1st, 2nd, etc.)

If still a tie, finishing order at last round will determine overall place winner.

Series Entry Fees: Support Classes \$25

Main Classes: Jmax, Rotax Light Rotax Heavy \$100 (Note: \$10, from each round, goes towards funding of the drivers representing Australia in the International Rotax Final. Only series entrants pay fee.

Clubman Light, Clubman Heavy: \$50

Race day entry fee: as per the supplementary regulations for each event.

Maximum number of series entries per class: 24

Note: The series registered drivers will have priority to fill the grid. Non registered series entrants can only be accepted on race day if there are available positions on the grid after series drivers have nominated.

There will be no oversubscribed classes/nominations accepted at any round.
