Provision for use of lights during the meeting:

Practice maybe extended to 8pm on Thursday to allow racing to continue on Saturday night if required, to allow "Finals Only" on Sunday and presentation at approximately 3pm.

CONTROLLED FUEL:

As per rule 22.03.7, the following controlled fuel requirements will be in place for this meeting.

PULP or ELF BKF07 are the control fuels for this event.

The only PULP fuel to be used at this meeting is Caltex Vortex 98 (PULP) and must only be purchased from the Caltex Service Station – 153 – 155 Nebo Road (Heading South)

“Controlled fuel” MUST be used from Friday 2nd July 2010 to Sunday 4th July 2010 Inclusive”

Fuel will be available for purchase from the Caltex Service Stations – 153 – 155 Nebo Road (Heading South) from Wednesday 30th June to Sunday 4th July 2010, INCLUSIVE.

Random samples of competitor's fuel will be taken during the course of the meeting and tested for conformity with samples taken from this supplier between these dates. Competitors are reminded that fuel tank and drums should be empty prior to being used for fuel purchased for use at this meeting. **No dumping of fuel will be allowed on site.**

General:

No pets (dogs/animals) are allowed in the track precinct. All scooter/bikes/skateboards are banned from the track precinct from Wednesday to Sunday; use of these items will result in confiscation.

Only person's holding a current registered drivers' licences are allowed to operate motor vehicles around the track precinct in accordance with Queensland State Road Rules and Regulations
